CHAMBER MEMBER NEWS

Camden National Bank announced that they are now accepting nominations for the 2019 Leaders & Luminaries Awards. This year, the bank will award a total of \$20,000 to four local nonprofits on behalf of board directors who demonstrate passion, innovation and resourcefulness in their board service, fostering organizational success and sustainable board governance. Since 2011, Camden National Bank has awarded \$130,000 to Maine nonprofits on behalf of 37 outstanding board leaders. An independent selection committee, including the Executive Director of MANP, two executives of Camden National Bank, and two additional Maine leaders who are active in the nonprofit community, will review all nominations, which are due August 30th, 2019.

The check was a grant from the Society's national headquarters in Baltimore, MD matching the donation of the local Maine chapter earlier this year.

Kennebec Behavioral Health is pleased to announce its 2019 college scholarship recipients. This year, the eight students will each receive a \$1000 scholarship upon successful completion of their first semester at their chosen college or university. The scholarships are made possible through KBH's College Scholarship program which developed in order to invest in our communities' future mental health professionals. The program

is the recipient of KBH's annual fall fundraiser comedy show, "A Night Out" which will be held this year on Saturday, November 2nd at the Calumet Club in Augusta.

The Kennebec Valley YMCA and the Friends of Lithgow Library are partnering again this year on a raffle fundraiser. The cost to enter is \$100 per ticket. Each ticket may be purchased by an individual or by a team of up to ten individuals. Those listed on the winning ticket will receive the grand prize of \$10,000. The money raised through the raffle will go toward the YMCA's Strong Kids Annual Campaign and Lithgow's Annual Campaign. The grand prize will be drawn on October 22, 2019 from 5:30 8pm at the Lithgow Library in Augusta. The ticket drawing event attendance will be limited to one representative, plus guest, for each ticket sold.

The Kennebec Valley YMCA will honor Jim Nichols with The John Bridge award on October 5th at the KVYM-CA's 12th Annual Auction. Join the KVYMCA at the annual event to recognize Jim and to bid on silent and live auction items. All money raised will go toward KV YMCA scholarships, including memberships, camperships, learning center education and swim lessons, in addition to many other scholarship opportunities that the KV YMCA provides to those in our community who could otherwise not afford it. Tickets are \$45 per person or a table of 8 for \$350. The Auction will be held on October 5th at 5pm in the KV YMCA Harold Alfond Gymnasium in Augusta.

MaineGeneral Health is one of three health systems in the U.S. to be named 2019 Patient Financing Top Performers by patient financing service provider ClearBalance® in conjunction

with the Healthcare Financial Management Association (HFMA). MaineGeneral began using the ClearBalance program in 2018 and is being recognized for Top Performer – Greatest Impact to Patients. In seven months, the ClearBalance program helped patients manage their medical costs for nearly 16,000 hospital visits. During that same time, an average 290 patients per month used the ClearBalance program to manage their costs for additional services at MaineGeneral Health, either for themselves, their spouse or dependents.

MaineGeneral Medical Center has launched a new service aimed at improving care in its Emergency Departments. MaineGeneral is in the process of bringing on medical scribes to document patient visits while medical staff care for patients. MaineGeneral plans to employ a total of 30 medical scribes from the local area to join the Emergency Departments in both Augusta and Waterville. Sixteen have been hired thus far and are already working with medical and nursing staff, who are happy with the early results.

Augusta's National Night Out is part of a national celebration held throughout the United States to promote crime prevention and substance free community programming.
